«*Leah Remini* is running. I'm running and running into a space where a horse foot is wearing a horse shoe but it's so big, and it's a flip flop. *Leah Remini* addresses the frequent leaving and re-entering of a place. The setting keeps shifting at a different frequency than its participants. Disorder camouflages the tension of finding new modifications for the same presentation. The works run with unreliable transportation, failing to adjust, but continuously in motion in order to manage the new actuality. *Leah Remini* is what it looks like to be simultaneously running away and running towards something elsewhere.»

Molly McDonald (b.1997) is a ceramic artist born and raised in Langhorne, Pennsylvania. They use contradiction, hyperbole, and jest, to examine the entanglement of lived experience and new growth.

McDonald has held residence at the Watershed Center for Ceramic Arts and was awarded the chance to attend Haystack Mountain School of Crafts. They hold a BFA in Ceramics from the Tyler School of Art and Architecture and participated in the University of Arkansas' post-baccalaureate program from 2019-2021. McDonald is currently pursuing their Master of Fine Arts at the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA).
